



### Suit for Forest Fire Fighting and Rescue Operations model TRENTO



Forest firefighting and USAR suit model **TRENTO** in 185 g/m<sup>2</sup> meta-aramid fabric doubled on the front 185+185 = 370 g/m<sup>2</sup>. It is flame retardant, antistatic, IOR (hydro oil repellent) Rip-stop (tearproof).

Composition: 93% meta-aramid, 5% para-aramid and 2% antistatic fiber.

The suit is composed by jacket and trousers that can be **joined** together by means of a perimeter zip fixed to the garment with a flame retardant elastic fabric band.

#### Jacket TRENTO Cod 80.0101.035

Front closure with brass zip covered by a 70 mm flap. Fixed at three points with Velcro FR; 3-pieces sleeves for easy of movement, cuff with adjustable elasticated fastener, 9 cm high "American" collar with throat flap fixed with Velcro FR; internal padding near the elbows with fireproof felt made with 250 gr. meta and para-aramid fibers; extended rear jacket hem to allow greater back protection; radio pocket with flap closure positioned on front left side and torch holder loop positioned on the right. Two welt pockets with 15 cm opening closed by flap with Velcro FR.

Reflective stripe positioned on the chest and waistline. On the waistline of the back double vertical stripes on the biceps and on the perimeter of the forearm.

#### Trousers TRENTO Cod 80.0102.020

Front flap closed by brass Zip, inserted in the belt for jacket anchoring, n. 4 x 35mm loops,; no. 2 patch pockets on the front with F.R Velcro fastening, n. 2 patch pockets on the sides closed with flap and Velcro FR, n. 2 back pockets closed with flap and Velcro FR; reinforcement with preformed patches inserted internally near the knee with fireproof felt made with 250 gr meta and para-aramid fibers.

N. 2 50 mm reflective, perforated and certified FR, stripes applied on the bottom of the leg.

Seams made with Nomex thread with two-needle processing.
